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

Tips for Family Reading


Engaging in story time regularly helps toddlers feel secure and stable, while providing the family with an opportunity to enjoy reading together. How can you integrate reading into your daily routine? Choose a fixed time as well as a pleasant and comfortable location. You can create a small “ritual” around story time – bringing the book to your favorite place, playing a song, or chanting something like: “It’s time for fun, come have a look, it’s time to sit and read a book!”





Each Page is a World Unto Itself

The structure of this book allows us to pause and delve into each page – one at a time. You can read the same page over and over again, emphasize the key word, look at the illustration, and discover what intrigues your toddler. You can also say, for example: “The boy is stepping on the leaves, which rustle”.



Movement in Words

You can add movement to the words. For example, gently blowing on your toddler’s forehead can represent the curl blowing in the wind. A circular motion with your finger can represent the shape of the curl. A light tap of your fingers on the book can represent the pitter-patter of the rain, and, of course, tickling!





Just Like in the Book!

You can look for the “words” in the book around your home or surroundings. For example, you can ask – What else rustles? Let’s hear some things rustling. And what rings? Let’s ring the doorbell. Who has a curl on their forehead or on top of their head? Let’s play on the swing set, just like they do in the book!
