Tips for Family Reading

Who says stories can only be read at bedtime? Maybe you prefer to read together in the afternoon while lying on the carpet, or have one of your stuffed toys join in? You should look for the best time and setting for you and your child to read together, and create your very own special story time

What Makes a Story Intriguing?

To encourage a joint discussion and discover what intrigues toddlers, you can check out together, for example, what else can one see from Yael's balcony? Instead of pointing and asking: "What's that?", you can wait and see what are the toddlers pointing to themselves? What are they identifying? You can follow this up with further elaboration, naming, or descriptions, such as "the ball is rolling" or "the ball is yellow".

Who is Coming? And Where do They Disappear To?

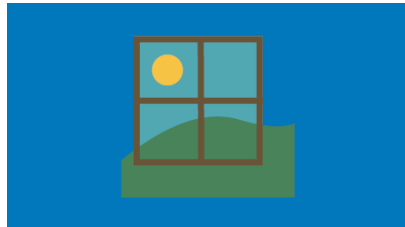
