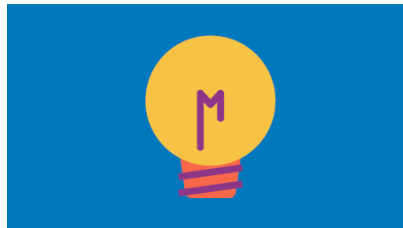

Beauty Exhibition

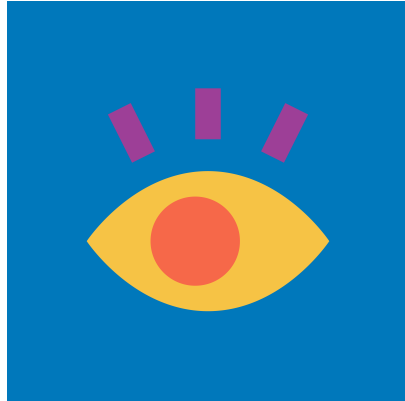

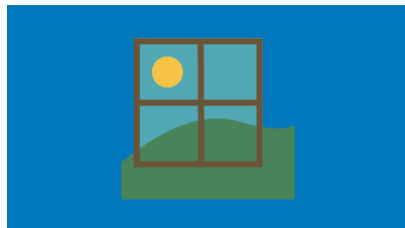
Family Beauty

In the Eyes of the Observer — A Trip of Investigation

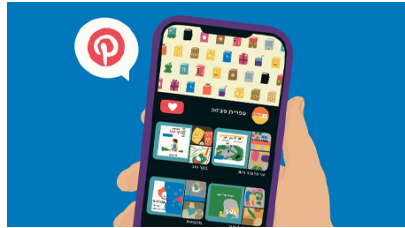
